

Document Justifying Exemption from Energy Labeling

Subject: LED Wall-Mounted Decorative Sign – Exemption from Energy Labeling Requirement

Product Description:

- **Product Type:** LED wall-mounted decorative sign.
- **Brand:** "CANDYSHOCK" – "GINGA"
- **Main Function:** Decorative, intended for advertising or decorative purposes, not intended to illuminate spaces in a general way.
- **Intended Use:** Used as a signage light for interior or store use

Applicable Regulations:

According to **Regulation (EU) 2019/2015** and Directive 2009/125/EC regarding eco-design requirements for energy-related products, energy labeling is mandatory for **light sources** (such as table lamps, ceiling lights, spotlights) that are intended to provide **general illumination** of spaces. However, **decorative light signs** or products with a **purely decorative purpose** are not considered general lighting appliances and, therefore, are not subject to energy labeling requirements.

Reason for Exemption:

- **Decorative and Not Lighting:** The product in question has been designed exclusively for decorative purposes, such as advertising signage, and is not intended to provide general illumination for spaces or environments.
- **Not General Lighting:** Based on the regulation, light signs that are not intended to illuminate large areas or spaces (such as living areas, offices, stores, or public areas) are not required to carry an energy label.

Conclusion:

Since the light sign is classified as a decorative product and not intended for general lighting, it is deemed that the energy labeling requirement does not apply according to European regulations.
